WEEK ENDING: 21st October 2018

A pretty good weeks fishing which produced some good sport but hard at times.

The rod average was just under 2 fish per person. Well done to Mr E Brey who had a 5lb Rainbow caught on a Diawl Bach and well done to Jeremy Summers who caught 8 fish in one day which was the most for any person.

The water level is heading in the right direction now and is nearing 60% full. Expect trout to be in the shallows feeding as the water levels rise over the next week or two.

The best flies and locations are the same as last week with the Lawns and Clampitts producing and Diawl Bachs, Claret Snafflers, PTN's and Damsels doing well. There are also some cracking browns being caught.
