There was some good sport to be had last week with a rod average of nearly 2 fish per person.

There was a cracking 3lb brown caught and released by Richard Powlesland from Crediton which was the largest of the week. The best bag was caught by Mr N Rabbits from a boat on 25th October when he landed 7 fish. Damsels, montana and Diawl Bachs were the best flies last week with occasional fish coming to boobies.

With the really cold mornings now the fish will be a little deeper than usual and the deeper water could be the best locations to try.

Boats will only be available until the end of October so hurry if you want one last boat outing before the season ends.
