

## Stithians Lake Catch Report 2 weeks ending 4<sup>th</sup> November 2018

Hi everyone,

Hope you have had a good couple of weeks. I have combined the two catch reports as I was away for most of last week, and seeing as there weren't many returns thought it would be better to just do one.

Despite the more wintry weather, there were still a few fish appearing at Stithians. Particularly well done to John Dolley who caught 2 rainbows in a session at Goonlaze Point using a cat's whisker. Also see below a picture of a rainbow caught by John Henderson at Pipe Bay using a small orange lure.

The water level is still very low, but water is being pumped in at the sluice now so hopefully it will start to pick up again soon!

Also, there is a small amount of blue green algae by the dam. This is only a very small amount and we have not been notified by South West Water that the critical level has been reached, so not a cause for concern. However, the algae can be toxic to dogs so worth keeping in mind if you are speaking to members of the public with dogs off leads!

At the bottom of the catch report I have attached some information from Ben about the end of the season. Fishing will stay open at Stithians until 30<sup>th</sup> November, and all season tickets will be valid until then. There is also an offer on our website for 20% off day tickets bought online using the promotional code 20RAINNOV18, so spread the word!
