Four nice brown trout taken at Burrator yesterday from the boat. Had 10 in total. Cracking day on a slime washing line with orange hopper and red tag fly.

Fish of the month the brown was 43.5 cm around 2.2lb



Really lovely fish, well done Kevin!

Strangely enough there is still a lot of fly life around at Burrator, despite the cold conditions. Lots on the surface of the water early in the morning, and with the water being so still I've been seeing a lot of fish movement in the shallows!

Also, EXCITING NEWS! Over the winter months, I will be working to clear/open up some more swims, around Longstone and also on the West and South banks – if you would like to get involved please do send me an email... the more of you that get involved, the more swims we can clear! Have your say and make your voice heard and make some new swims for next season!

I suggest using brighter coloured flies/nymphs in mid-deep water, at Longstone or between the dams in the deep water.

We have a new fishing notice board up on the wall of the permit hut and there is some space for a few photos so if you would like to send me a photo of your catch/es with catch details, I'll print a few of them off and put up in the notice board every week!
