

Fernworthy weekly fishing report

Week ending 8th September 2019

Tactics and information:

Three returns from Fernworthy last week but there were 13 fish caught. Black and peacock spiders working well and the odd fish to beetle imitations. When the sun was shining there was a small hatch of sedge and fish did take off the surface. Black nymphs also produced.

Paul Ackland was the leading anglers catching 8 fish on his visit ranging from 120z to 1lb 4oz all caught on dry sedge or black nymphs. Brownhills was the best location for Paul.

It looks like the fishing has picked up again and you can look forward to a few good weeks before the season closes in mid October.
