Boat fishing is still the best option at Kennick with the deeper water producing a few fish with browns feeding more than the Rainbows. The water level is high at 90% for this time of year and the water temperature is less than 20 degrees which is also unusual for the beginning of September.

Darren Everitt had a cracking Rainbow of 3lb 12oz last week! Damsels and blobs have been the best flies with some dry fly action too.

We are looking at stocking again now and will be discussing this with our suppliers.
