

Kennick bank pairs competition

17 May 2020

Rules and Information

1. The "Kennick Bank pairs" is a bank fly fishing competition. The competition venue will be Kennick Reservoir, Bovey Tracey, Devon on Sunday 17 May 2020. The competition HQ is situated in the Lodge, by the boat moorings.
2. The competition is open to all anglers. Pre-entry is recommended. Entry forms and competition information are available from South West Lakes Ltd, Lidn Park, Quarry Crescent, Pennygillam Ind Est, Launceston, Cornwall, PL15 7PF. Telephone 01566 771930.

Anglers wishing to compete are advised to pre-enter using the official entry form. Entry numbers may have to be restricted to avoid overcrowding.

If the event is over subscribed, unsuccessful entrants will be notified. Anglers are advised to return entries early to avoid disappointment. **Entry on the day may not be possible.**

3. Closing dates for entries will be Friday 15 May.
4. Entry Fees - £60 per pair
5. Competitors must have a current Environment Agency Rod Licence.
6. Cheques should be made payable to South West Lakes Ltd and enclosed with entry form to cover the total sum due.
7. Competitors must register at Competition HQ between 0800-09.00 hours on the day of the competition. No competitor may leave the Competition HQ prior to the briefing at 09.00. No fishing before competition start time 9.30. Competitors may not lay claim to any fishing station prior to dispersal.
8. The lake will be divided into 2 zones. Zone 1 will be from the Lodge to the causeway and Zone 2 will be from the causeway to the dam. One angler from your pair must fish in each zone and then swap at lunch time.
9. Fishing times are 9:30 -12:30 with half an hour for changeover and then 1-4pm
10. Fishing methods will be in accordance with the rules and regulations of the fishery contained in the Kennick Regulations
11. Bag Limit of 6 fish per person. Maximum of 5 fish in a zone.
12. All Rainbows and Blues must be killed. Browns must be returned.
13. There will be **NO TIME BONUS** for finishing early.
14. Maximum of 3 flies and 3 hook points. No Snake flies
15. Every competitor will keep his catch separate from that of any other competitor.
16. No competitor shall fish within 10 meters of another

- 17.** All fishing shall cease on the sound of the finish klaxon at 16:00 hours. A fish being played and landed after the signal to cease fishing shall be eligible for weighing if hooked before finish klaxon sounds at 16.00 hours.
- 18.** On return to the competition HQ, all competitors must report to the Weigh-In-Stewards(s) by 16.30.
NIL RETURNS MUST BE RECORDED.
- 19.** The winners will be the pair with the heaviest combined weight of fish. Brown trout and coarse fish do not count and must be returned. If there is a tie for weight the pair with the most fish shall be the winners. If it is, still a tie the Pair with the largest individual fish shall be winners.
