

PENINSULA CLASSIC FLY FISHING COMPETITION KENNICK RESERVOIR 21 June 2020

Rules and Information

1. The "Peninsula Classic" is an annual bank fly fishing competition. The competition venue will be Kennick Reservoir, Bovey Tracey, Devon on Sunday 21 June 2020. The competition HQ is situated in the Lodge, by the boat moorings.
2. The "Peninsula Classic" is open to all anglers. Pre-entry is recommended. Entry forms and competition information are available from South West Lakes Ltd, Lidn Park, Quarry Crescent, Pennygillam Ind Est, Launceston, Cornwall, PL15 7PF. Telephone 01566 771930.

Anglers wishing to compete are advised to pre-enter using the official entry form. Entry numbers may have to be restricted to avoid overcrowding.

If the event is over subscribed, unsuccessful entrants will be notified by return of post. Anglers are advised to return entries early to avoid disappointment. **Entry on the day may not be possible.**

3. Closing dates for pre-entries will be **19 June 2020.**
4. **Entry Fees**
£35.00 – Adult
£10.00 - Child under 16/Wheelchair disabled
5. Competitors must have a current Environment Agency Rod Licence.
6. Cheques should be made payable to South West Lakes Ltd and enclosed with entry form to cover the total sum due.
7. All competitors must leave their vehicles as directed.
8. Competitors must register at Competition HQ between 0800-09.00 hours on the day of the competition. No competitor may leave the Competition HQ prior to the briefing at 09.00. No fishing before competition start time 9.30. Competitors may not lay claim to any fishing station prior to dispersal.

The lake will be divided into 4 sectors. Draw will be made for initial sector. Every 2 hours Competitors will move to next sector at the sound of the klaxon (not before). All sectors will then be fished by each competitor before end of competition. Stewards will be on site to assist if required.

9. Fishing methods will be in accordance with the rules and regulations of the fishery contained in the Kennick Regulations except that **10 fish bag limit** will apply to competitors. There will be **NO TIME BONUS. MAX OF 3 FISH PER SECTOR (APART FROM FINAL ZONE , where there is no limit). Rainbow and Blue trout only.**
Fly size – the hooks shall be a single hook, i.e. no double or treble hooks.

Competitors may fish up to 3 flies per cast, 3 hook points, no snake flies

Every competitor will keep his catch separate from that of any other competitor.

10. No competitor shall fish within 10 metres of another competitor without first requesting, and receiving permission to do so.
11. All fishing shall cease on the sound of the finish klaxon at 17.30 hours. A fish being played and landed after the signal to cease fishing shall be eligible for weighing if hooked before finish klaxon sounds at 17.30 hours.
12. On return to the competition HQ, all competitors must report to the Weigh-In-Stewards(s) by 18.00.
NIL RETURNS MUST BE RECORDED.
13. Anglers may continue to fish after the prize giving until one hour after sunset, subject to a day's catch of 6 trout.
14. The championship prizes will be determined by the catch of each competitor. Any Brown trout and coarse fish will not be eligible and must be returned.
