

Fernworthy weekly fishing report

Week ending 22nd March 2020

Tactics and information:

Unfortunately the fishery is now closed until further notice. Please stay safe at this difficult time.

Our first full week at Fernworthy produced some good fishing. Dean Boucher caught 10 fish and had this report for us:

‘All the fish caught on wets on a floating line. Caught fish on Black Tadpole, B&P Spider and Bibio all on size 12`s. A mixture of fish caught with 7 stock fish and 3 overwintered fish. Condition of the overwintered fish was good. Nice bit of fishing but it was really chilly in the strong Easterly breeze. Odd small black buzzers seen’.

Mr Hawkins caught two fish of 1lb on his visit using a B&P spider fished just below the surface from Thornworthy Bank.

This year we stocked Fernworthy with the same amount of quality brownies from Torre Trout Farms. There were fish ranging from 7 inch up towards the 2lb mark.
