Seen some nice bags come out of Kennick over the past week, with both boat and bank anglers bagging up!

Fish were being caught from Laployds all the way up the narrows to the causeway, with clampitts also producing results.

On the boats, outer clampitts is very productive at the moment in the slightly deeper water.

Gold head damsels, nomads and Cats Whiskers were getting the best results over the last week.

Cracking report and photos below from regular angler, Mr. Herring.

It was milder to-day (if you can call 8.5C on arrival and 10C when I packed up at Middy).

Apparently fish were being caught 'in the middle, out from Clampets', so that's where I took the boat and a sinking line, bagging up and returning another. Some cracking rainbows weighing 2-14, 2-8, 2-5, 2-3, 2-0 and 1-14. One of them took me out to the backing (first time since early June last year!). Flies were Damsel and size 14 short shank Montana.
