Well the weather has started to clear up ... slowly... but it still feels like winter! Lots more anglers this week, with 116 fish caught to 37 returns putting the average at 3.13

The largest fish was a rainbow of 3lb 2oz by M Malpas on 17th Feb. Fish were being caught from Laployds all the way up the narrows to the causeway, with clampitts also producing results.

On the boats, outer clampitts is very productive at the moment in the slightly deeper water.

Gold head damsels, nomads and Cats Whiskers were getting the best results over the last week.
